





Five things you can do to prevent or recover stolen equipment.



Equip your machines with GPS **LOCATION TRACKING SYSTEMS**. If they are stolen, you'll be able to quickly locate and recover them.



REPORT IT

If a machine is stolen, CALL THE POLICE first. Then call the equipment manufacturer. When the machine is brought to a dealer for repairs, it will show up on the manufacturer's stolen equipment database.



Use AN ELECTRONIC KEYING **SYSTEM** to key all your equipment with the same code, or code each key to a specific operator. These systems can't be hotwired. The machines must be started with the key.



Weld your company name or phone number on the buckets, boom and frame. VISIBLE, HARD-TO-REMOVE IDENTIFICATION deters thieves and allows the police to quickly see who owns the machine.



Physical fences are good but not always practical. USE **ELECTRONIC GEO-FENCING** AND TIME-FENCING to alert you when machines are moved to the wrong place or started at the wrong time.
